Stourbridge Town station opened on 1 October 1879, when the branch from the original Stourbridge Junction station was built. The branch line was realigned in 1901 to serve the new Stourbridge Junction station. The station was closed from 1 April 1915 to 28 February 1919 as a wartime economy measure.

The original station was on the site of the current Bus Station but was demolished in February 1979 when the line was cut back by about 70 yards, and a new station built on the west side of the line. The current station, on the east side of the line, opened on 25 April 1994.

The branch was originally double track, but became two parallel single lines in August 1935, one being the passenger branch and the other the goods branch to Stourbridge Wharf.
